What is Noun?

It is a word used to name a person, animal, place, thing, and abstract idea.

Type of Nouns

Possessive Nouns

Is adding a combination of an apostrophe and the letter "s."

The red suitcase is Cassandra's.

Proper Nouns

Names of days of the week, months, institutions, organisations, and religions

Many people dread Monday mornings.

Common Nouns

A person, place, or thing in a general sense.

Many child-care workers are underpaid.

Concrete Nouns

Names anything (or anyone) that you can perceive through your physical senses: touch, sight, taste, hearing, or smell. A concrete noun is the opposite of a abstract noun.

The judge handed the files to the clerk.

Collective Nouns

A group of things, animals, or persons.

The flock of geese spends most of its time in the pasture.
