

Adjectives are words that describe or modify another person or thing in the sentence.

- ➢ the tall professor
- > the lugubrious lieutenant
- ➤ <u>a solid</u> commitment
- ➤ <u>a month's</u> pay
- ➢ <u>a six-year-old</u> child
- the unhappiest, richest man

The adjective forms are positive, comparative, and superlative.

This tree is <u>tall</u>. (positive) That tree is <u>taller</u>. (comparative) The last tree in the row is the <u>tallest</u>. (superlative)
