Adjectives are words that describe or modify another person or thing in the sentence.

- the tall professor
- the lugubrious lieutenant
- a solid commitment
- a month's pay
- a six-year-old child
- the unhappiest, richest man

The adjective forms are positive, comparative, and superlative.

This tree is tall. (positive)

That tree is taller. (comparative)

The last tree in the row is the tallest. (superlative)
