The Goldchill is our top-of-the-line refrigerator. It's a bit expensive, but worth it. Both the refrigerator and the freezer are large, and it has an automatic ice-cube maker. Then there's the Cold Standard, an excellent appliance in the mid-price range. It includes an extra-wide freezer as well as a water dispenser. We also have the StayFresh, a budget model that's good if you have limited space. It offers adequate storage capacity and a freezer. You may also be interested in the Mini-Cool. This is a countertop model, so it's very convenient, but it doesn't have a freezer.
