(G) You have 10 second to read the situation and Question No. 25.

First, there's a lovely apartment on Seymour Road. It's furnished, close to the station, and just £600 a month. No animals, though. Another option is on Tintagel Way, which does allow pets. The rent is £520 and it's a 30-minute bus ride to the station. Alternatively, there's a garden apartment on Clarence Avenue for £575. No dogs, but cats are OK. It's only five minutes from the station on foot. Finally, we have a new apartment on Goldleigh Place for £595. There's an additional monthly fee of £25 for pets, though. A short walk gets you to the station.

(H) You have 10 second to read the situation and Question No. 26.

The new hospital computer system should be up and running on Monday. To help you master it, there'll be group training sessions for everyone tomorrow in the first-floor meeting rooms. The time you should attend will depend on your department. Anyone who is unable to make their designated time should join a different session, but please see me to confirm which one has enough space. Billing staff with start at 9 a.m. in Room 106, nursing administrators will be from 11 a.m. in Room 119, and those in medical records should attend from 2 p.m. in Room 108.

(I) You have 10 second to read the situation and Question No. 27.

Cross bikes offer more stability than road bikes, so they're better for kids. In this city, helmets are mandatory for children under 10. You can rent them for an additional \$3. I'll also need a security deposit on the bikes. We offer optional insurance, which covers any damage to the bikes, as well as personal injury and liability. Check the appropriate box at the bottom of the form if you want

the insurance. I'll give you a repair kit in case you get a flat tire, so please don't lose it.

(J) You have 10 second to read the situation and Question No. 28.

Taro's doing fine. He may sleep the rest of the day, but that's normal. Water is fine, but don't feed him until tomorrow. If he doesn't have an appetite in the morning, let us know—you may need to bring him back in. If he does wake up today, it's best if he moves around as little as possible. In fact, he really should stay in his cage. Regarding medication, starting tomorrow he needs one of these pills every morning and evening with his meal. And don't hesitate to call if you have any concerns.
