A pronoun is a substitute for a noun. Some pronouns are:
I, me, she, he, her, him, it, you, they, and them.

1st Person Singular	I	me	my	mine	myself
2nd Person Singular	you	you	your	yours	yourself
3rd Person Singular	he she it	him her it	his her its	his hers its	himself herself itself
1st Person Plural	we	us	our	ours	ourselves
2nd Person Plural	you	you	your	yours	yourselves
3rd Person Plural	they	them	their	theirs	themselves
