An abstract noun is the name of quality, action, condition and feeling.

This quality, action, condition, thought or feeling is something that we cannot see, smell, taste, or touch. We can only think of it or feel it.

How abstract noun are formed

Abstract nouns can be formed from adjectives, or common nouns, or verbs. Suffixes are used to form abstract nouns.

The following are Noun-forming Suffixes:
