Common phrasal verbs, with meanings and examples. Phrasal verbs are usually two-word phrases consisting of **verb + adverb** or **verb + preposition**. Think of them as you would any other English vocabulary. Study them as you come across them, rather than trying to memorize many at once.

eat out	eat at a restaurant	I don't feel like cooking tonight. Let's <b>eat out</b> .
end up	eventually reach/do/ decide	We <b>ended up</b> renting a movie instead of going to the theatre.
