
## Phrasal Verb 101: Lesson 29 S

Common phrasal verbs, with meanings and examples. Phrasal verbs are usually two-word phrases consisting of **verb + adverb** or **verb + preposition**. Think of them as you would any other English vocabulary. Study them as you come across them, rather than trying to memorize many at once.

sort something out	mething		We need to <b>sort</b> the bills <b>out</b> before the first of the month.	
		ue doing something, limit elf to one particular thing		will lose weight if you <b>stick to</b> diet.
switch something off	omething		The light's too bright. Could you <b>switch</b> it <b>off</b> .	

<b>switch</b> something	start the energy flow, turn on	We heard the news as soon as we <b>switched on</b> the car radio.
on
