cut/pare (something) to the bone

- cut down severely (on something)

The company had no money so all of the extra expenses were cut to the bone.

down to the bone

- entirely, to the core

The rain and snow chilled me right down to the bone.

feel (something) in one's bones

- sense something, have an intuition about something

I feel it in my bones that I am not going to get the job that I want.
