risk one's neck (to do something)

- risk harm in order to do something
The fireman risked his neck to save the young child.

save (someone's) neck/skin

- save someone from danger/trouble/embarrassment The worker tried to save his own neck without thinking of any other people.

stick one's neck out (for someone or something)

- do something dangerous or risky for someone My friend will never stick his neck out to try and help other people.
