

One track mind. For example: He only ever thinks about girls, he has a one track mind.	A tendency to think about only one subject.
Cover your tracks . For example: They'll never catch the real culprits at Enron, they were to good at covering their tracks.	To hide or conceal something.
Public transport . For example: "People should use public transport more to avoid congestion on the roads."	A system of vehicles such as buses and trains which operate at regular times on fixed routes and are used by the public.
Travel light. For example: "I always travel light when I go to England."	To go on a journey without taking a lot of things with you
