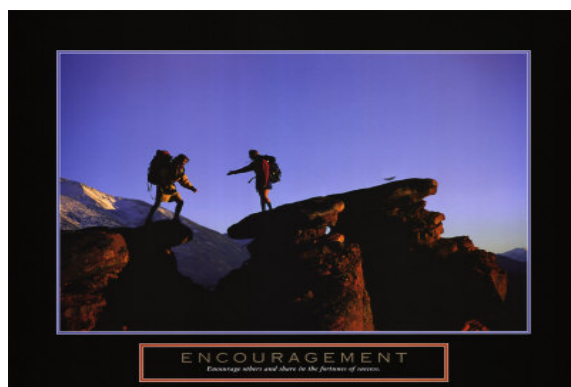

You Scratch My Back, I'll Scratch Yours (let's help each other...)
