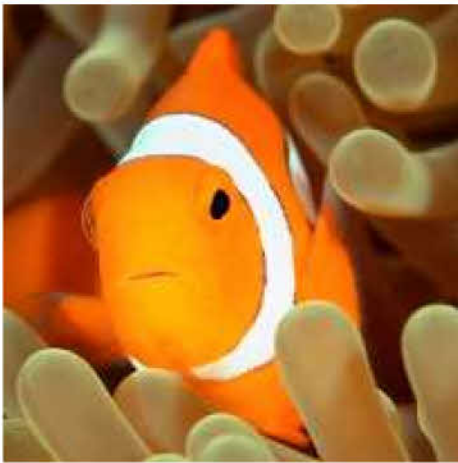


13.Can fish breathe underwater?
