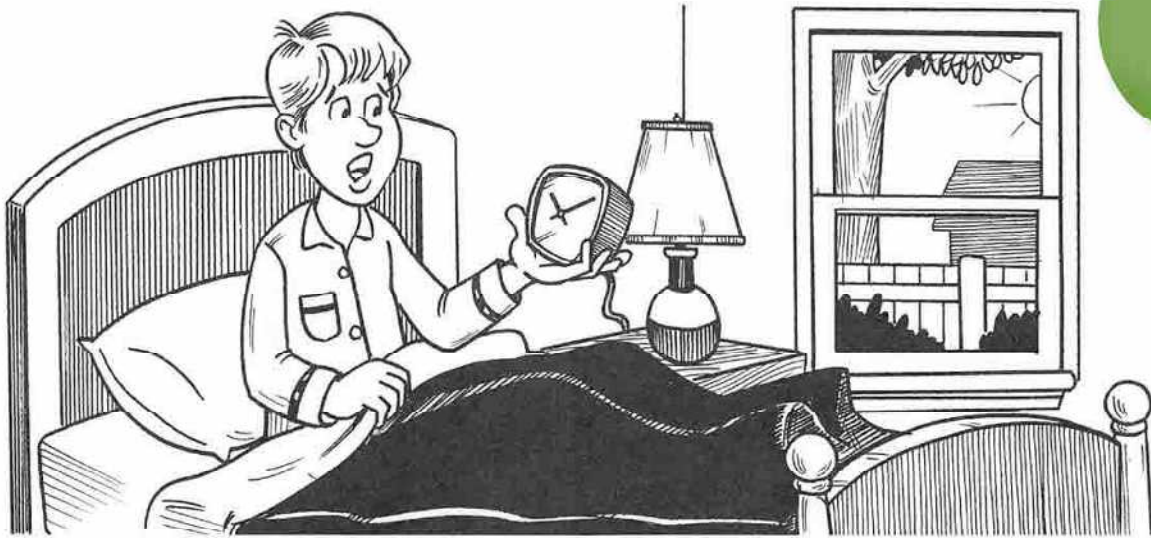


A HERBERT'S TERRIBLE DAY!
