<p>Bake - to cook inside an oven.</p>	<p><i>We are baking cake and cookies for mom's birthday.</i></p>
<p>Dishwasher - a machine that washes dirty plates, cups, forks, etc.</p>	<p><i>When Ann tried to wash the dishes using the dishwasher, she found that her chores were done much faster.</i></p>
<p>Mixing – combining or putting together things to form one mass.</p>	<p><i>Remember to mix the ingredients thoroughly or your bread won't come out right.</i></p>
