"Sweep under the bed"

Trash - Dispose of (something useless or old)

"trash these old chairs"

Wash - Cleanse with a cleaning agent, such as soap, and water

"Wash the towels, please!"

Dry - Become dry or drier

"The laundry dries in the sun"
